

# THE WATER TRAIL : FROM MILL TO LAUNDRY-TROUGH

→ SITUATION : CUZAC, 15 kms east of Figeac via the D840 then the D31

→ START POINT : Village square

GPS Coordinates : : N 44.580453° E 2.143034°

DURATION : 4 hrs.

LENGTH : 16.8 kms

WAYMARKING : Yellow



**1** Facing the church, turn right and go down the road as far as the junction with the D31. Turn right then immediately left on to the track which goes down to the former flour mill. Cross the stream and 250m further on, turn sharply right. Continue straight on to get to a tarmac track. Follow it going left for 300m, and on the bend, take the track going sharply off to the right. Follow it for about 800m, and leave it to take the path going up to the left. At the top of the rise, just before the houses, go left to get to Le Puech.

**1** At Le Puech, take the road to the right, go past an oratory on the left, and continue on the road up to a crossroads. Turn right towards Labat. Pass through the hamlet and immediately take the path going down on the left. At the D76, turn left on to it. When you get to the town hall, leave this road and go straight on to the church and the cemetery. At the church, turn right then immediately left, go past the cemetery and, soon after, leave the road to take a track going downhill opposite you. Continue straight on along this track which after a sharp right-hand bend, leads you into the valley of Le Donazac. At the bottom, cross the stream by the ford.

**2** Take the D41 going right. Leave it 400m further on, turning left on to a path which goes back up the coomb.

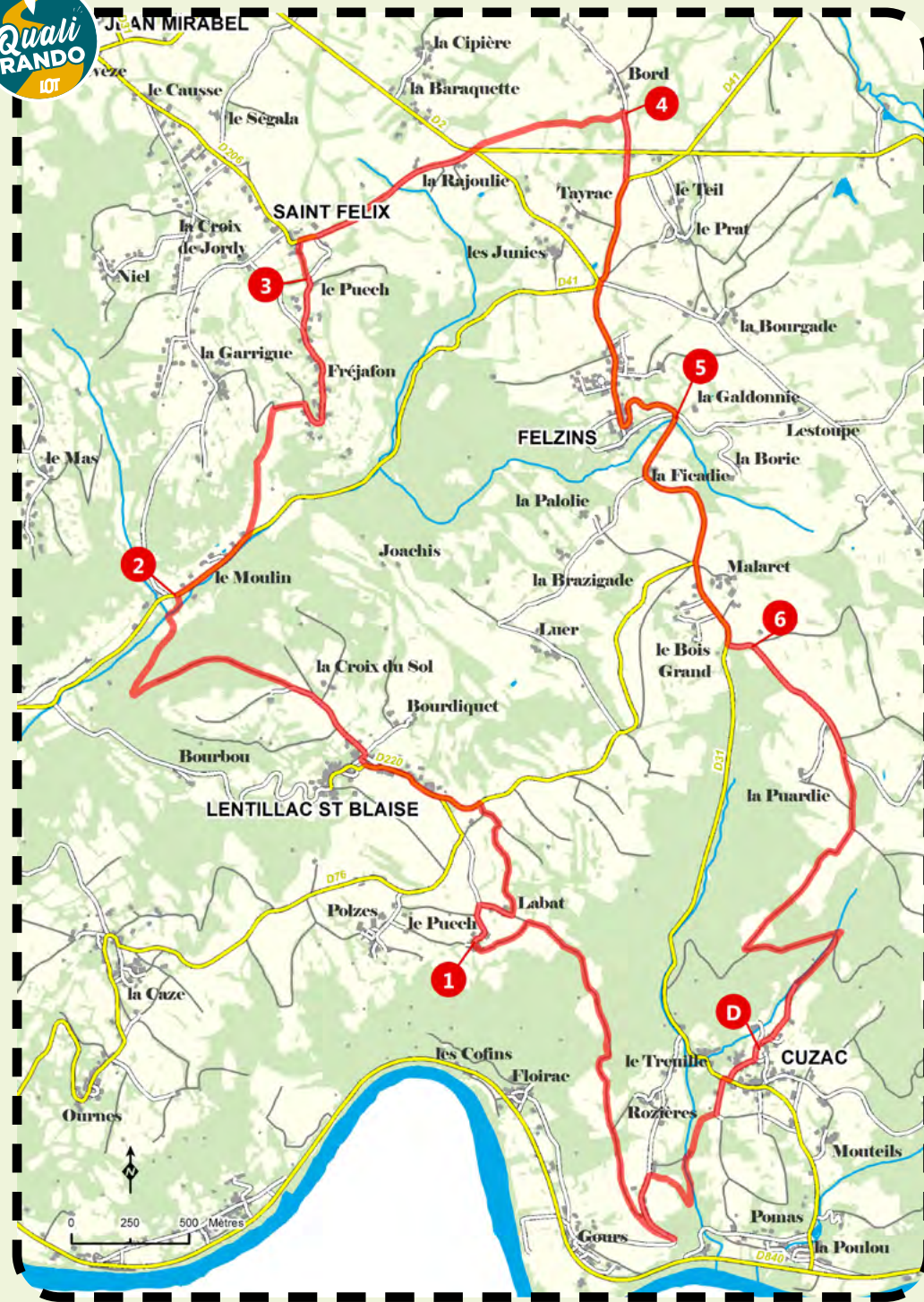
Follow this for 500m and at the 1st crossing, take the grassy track which goes steeply up towards the houses of *Fréjafon*. In the hamlet, follow the road to the left. At the fork, go to the right towards *St. Félix*.

**3** Before the village, you go to the left on the GR65 which follows a sunken lane. Take the GR going down on the right towards *St. Félix*. After the church, turn right towards *Felzins*, continue 100m further on the road then immediately take the path on the left. Cross the D2 which goes to La Cipièrre, still following the GR65. When you get to Bord, continue straight on and leave the GR65. Continue till you come to the D2.

**4** Cross the D2 and head for *Felzins* on the D41. At the roundabout, leave this to go slightly to the left on the D31. Go past the cemetery, into *Felzins* itself, and go through the village following the D31 to get to the laundry trough below the village.

**5** Stay on the D31 going in the direction of *Cuzac*. After *Malaret*, at the hamlet of Bois Grand, turn left on the little road which goes up towards La *Gasquié* and La *Puardie*.

**6** Follow this for 1 km and, after a house with a roof made of stone slabs, go up to the right on a track usable by vehicles. Take the first track on the right, then soon after, go left to get back down to *Cuzac*.
